<b>Description</b>	The bell has a simple inscription, in the third, between four cords, which mentions its manufacturer, the place and the year in which it was made: "THOMAS MEARS FOUNDER LONDON 1843". In the midfoot, there are three equidistant cords. Finally, in the middle foot, there are two cords.

<b>Ringsings</b>	Change ringing, Muffles: in funerals, Holy Week, All Saints' Day.
<b>Conservation, maintenance</b>	Excellent. The bell has its traditional features, including the wheel, rope, stop, stay, and top pole of the stop.
<b>Protection</b>	Protected under UK heritage law due to the church being under the National Heritage List for England as a Grade II listed building
